

Sen. Dan Lauwers (R-Brockway Township) was elected to the Michigan Senate in 2018, representing the 25<sup>th</sup> Senate District which includes Huron, St. Clair, and Sanilac counties as well as Armada Township, Memphis, New Baltimore, Richmond and Richmond Township in Macomb County.

Lauwers serves as chair of the Senate Energy and Technology Committee and vice chair of the Insurance and Banking Committee. Lauwers is also a member of the committees on Agriculture; Economic and Small Business Development; Government Operations; Regulatory Reform; and Transportation and Infrastructure.

Before serving in the Senate, Lauwers served three terms as a State Representative for the 81<sup>st</sup> District.

Prior to his time in the Legislature, Lauwers founded Eastern Michigan Grain in 1993 and led the company through 2013. He previously worked for the W.K. Kellogg Foundation and the National Milk Producers Federation. He also served as a legislative assistant in Washington D.C. to former Congressman Bill Schuette.

Lauwers earned a bachelor's degree in agricultural economics with an emphasis on marketing from Michigan State University.

He and his wife, Kellie, have three children.
